ntroduction

Intimately Pursued by a Passionate, Loving God

Carvings In His Palm, *What God Thinks When He Whispers Your Name* is a prophetic work birthed from the heart of God and whispered into the heart of His beloved. The work consists of a compilation of conversations and dialogs with the heavenly Father as He whispered during the intimate moments of Brenda's life and the lives of her friends, teaching them many overcoming truths. The Word and worship, along with experiences of life, were the catalyst the Father used to teach the truths within as she was inspired by her friends Eustacia Siman Martinez and Veryl Williams, while being intimately pursued by Him.

Each love letter is followed by a *What is God Thinking* journal page. The love letters are then divided into five or six Whispers (devotions) of contemplation which include a prayer of affirmation and declaration, along with questions to reflect and meditate on. A *Whisper Time* has been provided at the end of each Whisper (devotion) to record intimate whispers from the Father's heart to the reader. They can be used in response to the book or the readers own personal life.

The reader is lead on a journey which encourages them to partake of the grace, goodness and mercy of the Lord Jesus Christ. Though written in love letter format, each letter is grounded and based on the Word of God.

Carvings In His Palm, What God Thinks When He Whispers Your Name is designed to present God's point of view in many areas of life, enabling the reader to circumvent destructive pitfalls and receive the encouragement to do it God's way. The underlying theme in this book is God's mercy, grace, and His overwhelming desire to reveal the fact that He sees us in Jesus; with love.

The book's purpose is to teach truth that frees in a loving and personal way and at the same time build an intimate relationship with the Father, removing all fear and creating self-esteem in the reader.

After many years of ministry, marriage counseling, home groups and personal one on one time with God's children, Brenda has come to know intimately the deepest need of a longing heart. *Carvings In His Palm, What God Thinks When He Whispers Your Name* meets this need, creating a sense of oneness with the Father who loves His children and wants them to know it.

These intimate dialogs come directly from the heart of the heavenly Father to the heart of His beloved, enabling a closer communion with Him. Written in this form they become very personal as if the reader is the only one on His mind.

The ultimate goal is to be encouraged to communicate with God on a personal intimate level, opening up an entire new dimension of relationship and receiving from Him.

As a result of reading and participating in reflection and contemplation, the reader will have a growing and increasingly dynamic confidence in the Lord. Come join us as He leads us on the healing journey of a lifetime by speaking His Father's heart into us, His beloved.

on To Use

Carvings in His Palm, What God Thinks When He Whispers Your Name is comprised of six love letters from the Father. Each chapter consists of one complete love letter and five or six Whispers (devotions) derived from said letter. Each Whisper (devotion) is concluded with a time of affirming prayer, reflection and a *Whisper Time* in which to give to and receive from the Father. They are not dated; therefore, have a timeless quality capable of lasting a lifetime.

Begin your intimate time with Father by reading one complete love letter from Him, letting it be absorbed into your spirit. Then take time and respond to the *What is God Thinking* journal page at the end of each letter. Pour your heart out to Him, listen and record what He speaks to you.

We then suggest you read one Whisper (devotion) derived from the complete love letter, daily or at your own pace, in order to ingest and digest, bite by bite, all the Father wants to say to you. Each daily Whisper (devotion) is accompanied by a prayer of affirmation, confession and declaration designed to be prayed and spoken over your life. At the end of each Whisper (devotion) some reflection questions are provided to encourage you to listen and hear what the Father is speaking to you in response to the word through the power and anointing of Holy Spirit. Space is provided to jot down notes to use in future times of reflection.

These questions are meant to be suggestions only. If you are stirred by the questions we provide or by other impressions or thoughts, take the time to respond to them. Start by writing them in your own *Whisper Journal* of love, instruction and remembrance. They become a heritage to your children and a memorial of all God has done and will do (Deuteronomy 29:29). The *Whisper Time* provided at the end of each Whisper (devotion) is meant to encourage you to move beyond prayer and reflection into a place of intimate hearing—into a time of dialoging with the Father.

Remember, the goal is not to hurry through, but instead, get His Word deep into your heart. Therefore, it doesn't matter how long it takes you to get through one Whisper (devotion). Take the time to record all Holy Spirit relays to you. Intimacy and communion is what matters, not time. This is where your own personal *Whisper Journal* will be of great value.

Seize the moment—seize the day, for He is near and ready to whisper to your heart with His words of love.

May the Lord richly bless you and speak into your life. May He make His face to shine upon you. May He bless you in your coming in and your going out. May you hear the whispers of His heart. — Brenda

Low To Use in a Group

Carvings in His Palm, What God Thinks When He Whispers Your Name is an excellent tool for small groups. It promotes intimacy with the Father and builds a deep relationship between the members of the group. Consider the example below.

A small group in San Antonio, Texas purchased the book and met together for a six-week period. They began their time by reading a complete love letter together and followed on with a "soaking time or resting in His presence while listening to soothing, worship music" which they downloaded at *www.soakingwithapurpose.com*. They would then reflect on, discuss, pray for each other needs and journal the whispers Holy Spirit spoke to their hearts. The rest of the week was spent reading the daily Whispers (devotions) related to said love letter. A time of personal soaking followed with reflection and journaling the whispers of Father's heart until they met again. They shared the following testimonies with me.

Contemplation of the Heart

"And God's peace [shall be yours, that tranquil state of a soul assured of its salvation through Christ, and so fearing nothing from God and being content with its earthly lot of whatever sort that is, that peace] which transcends all understanding shall garrison and mount guard over your hearts and minds in Christ Jesus" (Philippians 4:7 Amplified)



I have dwelt with you in your times of adoration. Your contemplations are sweet, aromatic moments to Me. They waft up through the heavens like sweet perfume and enter My senses like the smell of spring rain. They produce an abundance of fruitfulness in your life as I release them back to you in showers of blessing.

Affirmation
